

The proposed plan for the the league's security arrangement even offers immediate evacuation facilities in case of an emergency



6 Secure, cordoned off floors in hotels and rooms given to teams will be based on which are best protected from a security perspective.

5 Routes will be sanitised with alternative routes worked out in advance with the state administration. A plan based on the Chennai/Mumbai template, put in place for the Tests against England following the Mumbai attack, will be in place.

1 Monitoring of grounds and stands on CCTV at all stadiums

2 Fine-tuning a disaster management plan, that was conceived in advance of the Lahore attack. This includes having a quick evacuation plan in place. Bindra said one thing noticed about the Lahore incident was it took three hours to evacuate the Lankan team from the Gaddafi Stadium by helicopter and it shouldn't have taken that long.

3 Entrance only through turnstiles to facilitate ticketing and security checks

4 Security for dressing rooms/dugouts will be upped, as will stadium security, though Bindra also said they hope to do this with the least inconvenience to spectators, given that T20 games are supposed to be entertainers.
